Suggested itineraries

24 hours of fall

There's no shortage of local food in Montérégie, especially in the fall! From colourful flowers and produce to beautiful orchards and vineyards, there's so much to satisfy the palate and catch the eye.

About 130 km – 3 attractions – 1 day



- Au Beau Pré – U-pick flower farm.
- Ferme La fille du Roy – U-pick artichokes, squash (over 30 varieties), pumpkins, ground cherries and strawberries.

48 hours – Centre-Est bike loop

The vast majority of this family-friendly loop follows the Route Verte. Cyclists will be treated to magnificent bike paths surrounded by nature.

Day 2

From Granby to Saint-Jean-sur-Richelieu via Rougemont and Chamby (the Chamby Canal path and La Route des champs)

Montérégie-West

Nestled along the Richelieu River, less than 45 minutes from Montreal, the municipality is rightfully recognized as the nautical capital of Québec. Year after year, Saint-Paul-de-l'Île-aux-Noix offers a wide array of activities that help strengthen this reputation. In the summertime, it is at the heart of one of the most visited regions in the province. As you visit Fort Lennox on île aux Noix, you will come across the only fortification still standing on its original structure. Construction of the fort was completed in 1829. 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
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


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
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
