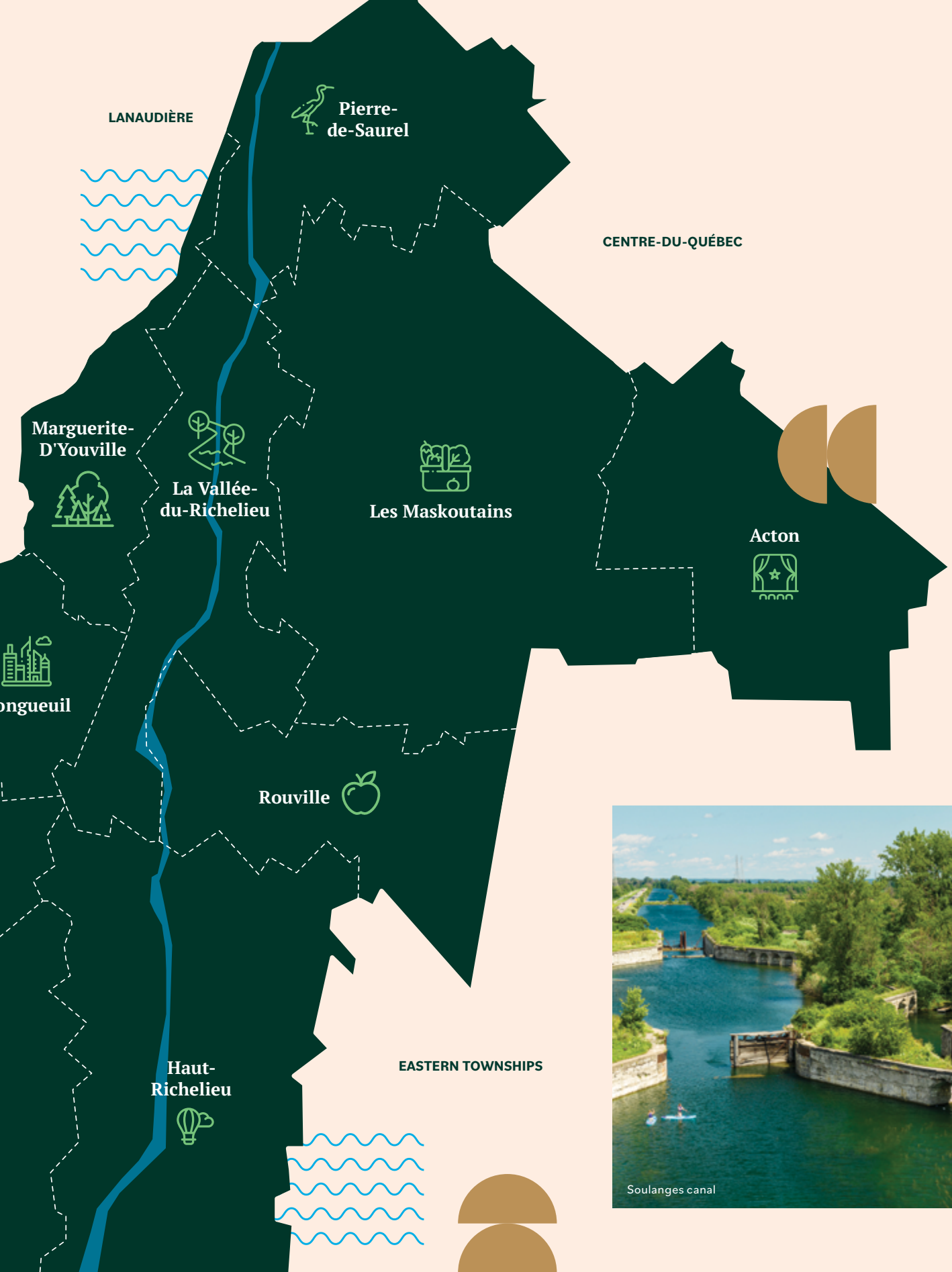

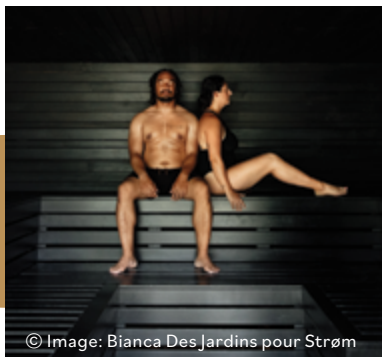

Located on the Petite-Caroline range in Rougemont, the Michel Jodoin Cidery is an invitation to journey through a century of tradition and innovation. From tasting exceptional ciders to enjoying nocturnal strolls, the cidery offers a range of unifying activities for visitors and the community. Discover the timeless charm of Michel Jodoin Cidery, a place where each season unveils new pleasures and discoveries.

A sweet mix of tradition and modernity passed down through generations

A family business that has been operating for over a hundred years owes part of its success to its openness, love for apples, and the team's desire for innovation. "We're not just a number business; it's important that we enjoy our work, take the time to appreciate it, and enjoy. What we want to inspire in the customer starts with our internal dynamics," says Michel Jodoin, the owner.

"The young people develop products for themselves, for their generation. I remain present and continue to be involved in the project, but I now act more as a mentor. We have a good relationship," acknowledges Michel. The human-level transition has been smooth as the cidery is a family business. With Michel and the trio Philippe, David, and Jean-Philippe, the orchard is in great hands. Each brings their own flair, their personal touch that makes the cidery offer a beautiful balance between precious tradition and the new effervescence that attracts new apple enthusiasts.

With heart

At the cidery, they don't rush things! Patience and love for the land are necessary for this kind of work. "We're not in a hurry; creating quality takes time. When you've been waiting two years for a bottle to be ready, we celebrate its arrival," shares Michel Jodoin. "We work a lot in partnership with our customers; our shop is where we test our products. We like to have visitors taste the new products and gather their feedback. It's a team effort from start to finish!" continues Michel. Beyond the apple, customers are at the heart of the cidery's work. The team is known for its warm welcome, and the premises have been thoughtfully designed to encourage visitors to relax and enjoy a moment in the Jodoin universe. Everything is considered. The warmth of the fireplace, the perfect lighting for the sparkle of glass, to the angle of the chairs at the shop. "We're not afraid to dare when it comes to improving our people's experience," asserts Michel. The cidery now offers seated tastings. Everything to invite visitors to take their time.

More than a cidery, a destination

The destination offers various formulas to pamper its clientele, including the headlamp circuit. Every two weeks, evening walks are organized on the 4.5 km trail behind the shop. Nearly fifty walkers each time come to contemplate the impressive panoramic view of all the mountains around the border. "At the end of the hike, we offer hot cider and an apple pie; in short, we want to spoil our people! We light the outdoor fires to bring people together, and everyone can stay and relax with friends," Michel rejoices. Also, "Reserve Your Bubble" is a new concept implemented this year on the site that allows people to enjoy a good bottle under the flakes while keeping warm inside a transparent bubble. Michel continues, "We keep it simple and casual! A lunch box with cheese, baguette, and a good bottle to enjoy the moment." Michel Jodoin Cidery, famous for its award-winning artisan ciders and immersive experiences, is undoubtedly a destination to discover during your next visit to Petite Caroline range in Rougemont.

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Au Gré des Champs: Savoring the Authenticity of Montérégie's Terroir



The Au Gré des Champs cheese factory, born from a family dream and fueled by a passion for the terroir, is the fruit of a love story between the land, the cows, and traditional know-how. Marie-Pier Gosselin, co-owner and the true soul of this establishment, opens the doors to her world where each cheese tells a story, that of Montérégie.

From farm to cheese factory, a family story

"When I was little, my mother used to test cheese making in the house," recalls Marie-Pier Gosselin, co-owner of the Au Gré des Champs cheese factory. It was after a trip to France, inspired by international cheese factory models, that the idea of the cheese factory began to sprout in her parents' minds. At that time, Terroir was barely part of the common vocabulary. "When we started, we had trouble filling the shop; now, we have to make choices given the quantity of terroir products. We are happy to let visitors taste the flavors of Montérégie."

The names of the cheeses reflect the producers' love for their region. Indeed, each name tells a part of Montérégie's story and opens up many discussions. Today, the cheese factory is a success, and Marie-Pier is slowly taking over the reins. "When the next generation integrates into a business, you bring your energy, your ideas, and a different breath. I had many projects, and my parents are really open."

Through the story of Marie-Pier and her family, we dive into the daily life of a cheese factory where craftsmanship becomes the bridge between the land and the plate, inviting everyone to reconnect with the deep roots of our Quebecois food heritage.

Cheesemaking craftsmanship open to the public

The discovery of vineyards has already won many hearts, but visiting a cheese factory like Au Gré des Champs promises an astonishing immersion into the very essence of Quebec's terroir. "Terroir is a complex concept. Consumers understand this concept well in the wine industry. We wanted to create this connection with the flavors of milk," shares Marie-Pier, revealing the ambition behind their approach: to create a bridge between visitors and the farm through the product.

From field to plate, reconnecting with our roots

In the past, most families had a farmer. Agriculture wasn't a well-kept secret, but today it's different. "We want to recreate the connection between the consumer's plate, the producer, and the land," specifies Marie-Pier. When Quebecers meet the producers, they discover the faces behind the products. This encounter creates a deep connection and gives immense value back to the producers. Seeing the cows' wellbeing with your own eyes, understanding the daily commitment to their quality of life, goes beyond any marketing argument one might find on packaging. Increasingly informed and concerned consumers deserve this transparency.

They notice the difference, and this awareness nurtures a loyalty built on trust. For many, the visit to the cheese factory evokes old-time memories, the scent of the farm, the soothing images of cows in the fields. These emotions, these memories, forge deep connections.

Easily accessible by bike, the surroundings offer visitors the chance to bring local flavors to their tables. Embark on a culinary adventure starting at Mont St-Grégoire to select a cider, then to the cheese factory, and end the day with a picnic in a vineyard, where a local cheese perfectly complements an excellent bottle produced on our Quebec lands. If that's not a flavorful getaway! It's an invitation to rediscover and reclaim the beauty of our region, one bite at a time.

Here, each tree carries the imprint of a family dream turned reality. Founded by two enthusiasts without agricultural backgrounds, this orchard is the result of a deep love for the land and the Hudson community.

Nestled in the green community of Hudson, Verger Hudson Bio is cultivated by a family producing healthy, organic fruit with freshness and natural taste. This little slice of paradise offers an immersive and warm experience, where every visitor can rediscover the joy of picking their own apples, in an environment where slowness, quality, and respect for living beings are paramount.

A dream realized

Unlike many families in the agriculture sector, the owners of Verger Hudson Bio, Éric and Anick, were not born into apples. It was a childhood dream of Éric's, who as early as 7-8 years old, was drawing orchards. A cabinetmaker by trade and a biology student, he has always had a closeness with the land and nature. Anick, coming from the tourism industry, continues to live her passion through the orchard that welcomes visitors from everywhere. "We can't see the moment when we'll be done with this passion," shares Anick.

The first step towards realizing their dream was the planting of 1,000 apple trees, a community effort that symbolizes the project's familial spirit. "We were the only crazy ones to plant an organic orchard in Hudson." "We learned on the job, especially the importance of having a deer fence around the orchard," chuckles Anick. Anick and Éric are passionate about their project and offer a diversified range at the orchard beyond picking, including art exhibitions. Visitors are invited to bring their picnic and enjoy an afternoon of simplicity.

The art of seasonality

At Verger Hudson Bio, embracing seasonality is not just an agricultural practice; it's a way of life. The seasons shape the family's daily life. The preparation period leads to seven bustling weeks of self-picking. "This seasonality is addictive and so stimulating! The self-picking season is a time when every day counts!" When you get to your season, you can't wait to see your customers, you can't wait for it to start again." adds Anick. "We love winter; it's our time to rest. We play outside and enjoy what the region has to offer. It's a wealth to raise our family in this seasonality. "We don't go south; we'll miss winter!"

Connection with nature

Attention to detail is very important for the owners, who prioritize the quality of the welcome rather than increasing tourist numbers. Quality of life, a pillar of the organic philosophy, dictates every decision made on the orchard. Accepting nature's limits on production capacity is seen as an opportunity to align agricultural practices with natural cycles. This flexible approach also allows for innovation in product transformation: potential losses turn into juice, cider vinegar, pies, and muffins, with special attention to full resource use, including recycling organic waste to feed chickens.

« We prefer to limit the number of places to take the time to chat with customers. This way, we maintain a slowness, a pleasant rhythm, and experience more authentic moments with our clientele. »

To conclude your adventure, you'll pass through the tourist hub of Chambly, where you'll find, among other things, the Fort-Chambly National Historic Site, the Gervais Désourdy Nautical Center, microbreweries Délires et Délices and Bedondaines & Bedons ronds.

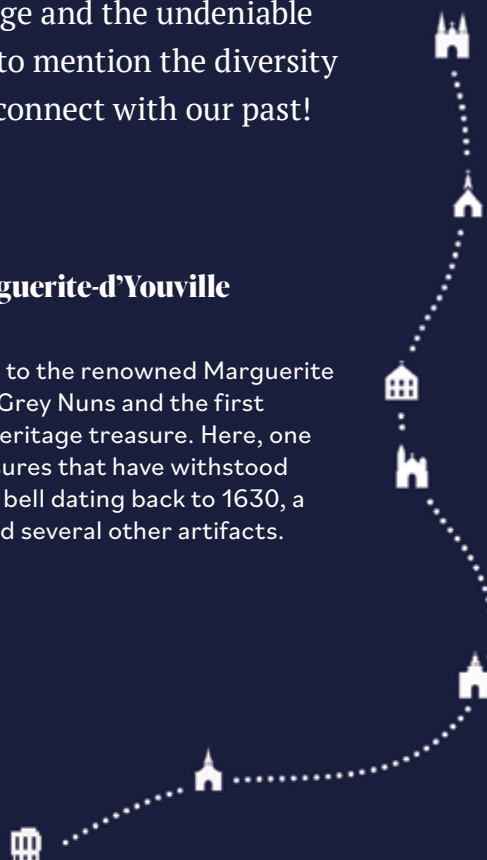

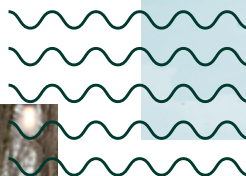

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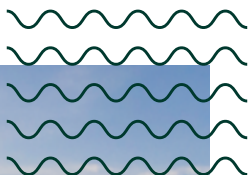
